AFTAB | EUROPE


"God, save me. Help me." This was Aftab's constant prayer for many years as he faced one life-threatening event after another. Falsely accused of blasphemy – a crime punishable by death – Aftab had to flee his home country. He thought friends in the local government would come to his aid.

No one was willing to help a Christian.

The consequences would be too great.

Weeks turned into months and months turned into years. His journey seeking asylum and safety took him to nine countries. He endured hunger and hopelessness, near-death experiences hiding in shipping containers and clinging to a raft by his fingertips, beatings from those in refugee camps who heard him speak openly about the mistreatment of Christians in his home country.
