Robert and Damian had both
grown up in troubled homes, and

out of Damian's home, where they'd been staying the last several months. "I asked them, 'Hey guys, we have that extra house on our property," Ryan says. "'Do you want to come live there?""

Ryan and Baylee gave Damian and Robert a house—and they gave them a home. They started including them in all their family activities. They loved them and listened to them. And then weeks later when Ryan shared the gospel with Robert, who'd never been offered an opportunity to follow Jesus, Robert made a decision. "I baptized him the following Sunday," Ryan says. "It was awesome."


